



Georgia Celebrates Quilts – 2009 Rules of Entry
Sponsored by the East Cobb Quilters' Guild, Inc. (ECQG)
September 18-20, 2009
Cobb County Civic Center, Marietta GA

Categories: Quilts/wearables must be the sole work of the entrant, with the exception of the Two Person and Group categories. If a category has an unusually large number of quilts, the appropriate ECQG committee and/or judges reserve the right to divide that category into two or more categories. Final placement in a category will be at the discretion of the appropriate ECQG committee and/or judges. No quilt can be placed in more than one category.

Sizes: Large Length plus width must be at least 140". Maximum width 120".
Medium Length plus width less than 140".
Miniature 24" or less on each side.

PIECED	Predominantly pieced quilts constructed by hand and/or machine. Minor amounts of appliqué are allowed. Sizes: Large and Medium.
APPLIQUÉ	Predominantly appliquéd quilts constructed by hand and/or machine, including fusible appliqué. Minor amounts of piecing are allowed. Sizes: Large and Medium.
COMBINATION	Quilts constructed by hand and/or machine with a balanced amount of piecing and appliqué. Sizes: Large and Medium.
ORIGINAL DESIGN	Quilts designed solely by the entrant using any construction technique. Quilts must not be from published patterns, books, class projects, or kits. Size: Any.
WHOLE CLOTH	Quilts where the design is created by the quilt stitch using a single piece of fabric. No piecing is permitted, except to join widths of fabric. Size: Any.
MINIATURE	Quilts with overall patterns that reflect reduced scale. Blocks, if used, must be 4" square or smaller. Size: 24" or less on each side.
WEARABLE ART	Wearable garments using one or more quilting techniques. Entries must contain three layers and must be quilted by hand and/or machine.
TWO PERSON QUILT (PIECED)	Predominantly pieced quilts constructed by hand and/or machine that include the work of two people in any part of the construction and/or finishing. Minor amounts of appliqué are allowed. This category includes quilting done for hire. Sizes: Large and Medium.

TWO PERSON QUILT (APPLIQUÉ)	Predominantly appliquéd quilts constructed by hand and/or machine, including fusible appliqué that include the work of two people in any part of the construction and/or finishing. Minor amounts of piecing are allowed. This category includes quilting done for hire. Sizes: Large and Medium.
TWO PERSON QUILT (COMBINATION)	Quilts constructed by hand and/or machine with a balanced amount of piecing and appliqué that include the work of two people in any part of the construction and/or finishing. This category includes quilting done for hire. Sizes: Large and Medium.
GROUP QUILT	Quilts created by three (3) or more people using any construction techniques. Size: Any.
MIXED TECHNIQUES	Any quilt that does not obviously fit into another category, such as: crazy quilts and quilts involving significant amounts of photo transfers, embroidery, painting, etc. Size: Any.
