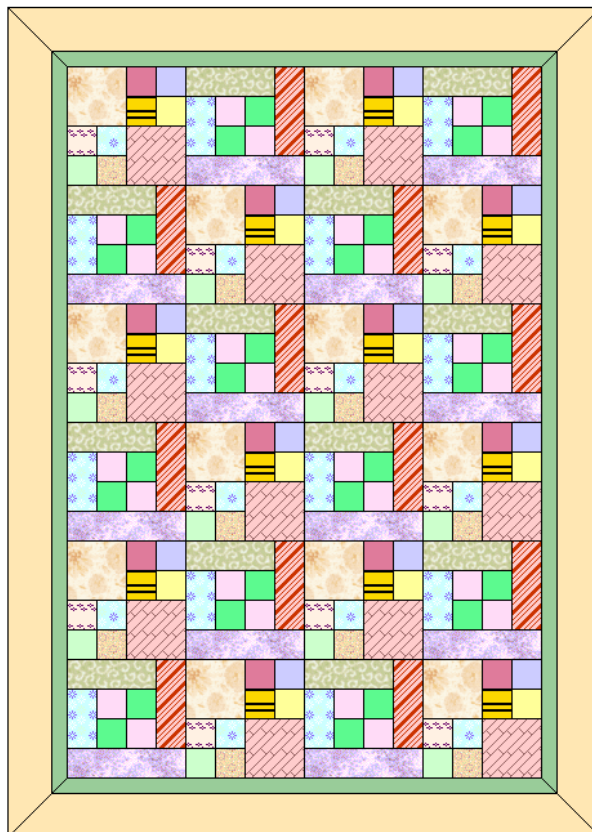


Frosted Candy

Finished Quilt size w/o borders
32 x 48
8" Finished Blocks

****Suggested borders, Fabric not included in Fabric Requirements**
Inner = 1" wide
Outer = 3" wide

Fabric requirements based on 40" wide
A = 1/2 yd 3 strips WOF 4 1/2" wide
B = 1/2 yd 5 strips WOF 2 1/2" wide
C = 1/2 yd 5 strips WOF 2 1/2" wide
D = 1/4 yd 2 strips WOF 2 1/2" wide
E = 1/4 yd 2 strips WOF 2 1/2" wide
F = 1/4 yd 3 strips WOF 2 1/2" wide
G = 1/4 yd 2 strips WOF 2 1/2" wide

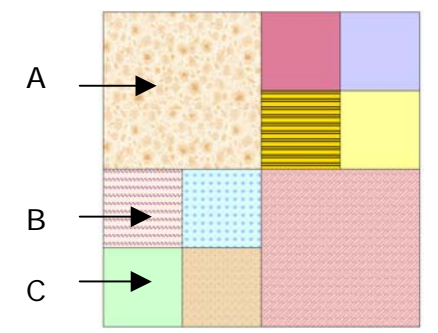


****Using fat 1/4 for D, E, F & G Cut strips 2 1/2" x 20-22" using longest side of fat 1/4. EXCEPT - F cut strips on 18" side of fat 1/4**

Block 1 Unframed 4-Patch

Sewing: **4-Patch**

4-Patch - Sew B strip lengthwise together with C strip to make five B/C strips. Crosscut into 2 1/2" wide segments. Make 72. Sew two units together to create a 4-Patch block. Make 36



Block 1 - Unframed 4-Patch

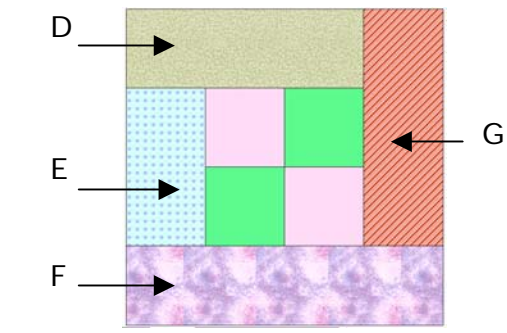
Cut A into 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares Make 24.
Sew one 4-Patch block to one A square. Make 24
Sew together two 4-Patch/A units. Make 12 blocks

Block 2 - Framed 4-Patch

Cut D strip into 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Cut 12
**** Fat 1/4 = four 2 1/2" strips LOF. Cut 12 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"**
Cut E strip into 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Cut 12
**** Fat 1/4 = three 2 1/2" strips LOF. Cut 12 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"**
Cut F strip into 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. Cut 12
**** Fat 1/4 = On 18" side cut six 2 1/2" strips. Cut 12 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"**
Cut G strip into 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Cut 12
**** Fat 1/4 = four 2 1/2" strips LOF. Cut 12 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"**

Block 2 - Framed 4-Patch

Referring to Framed 4-Patch picture, sew E rectangle to the side of a 4-Patch block. Sew D to adjoining side. Sew G to next adjoining side and sew F to remaining side to complete Framed 4-Patch. Make 12 blocks.



Assembly - Arrange alternating blocks to create quilt top four blocks across by six rows down.

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
